Categories

Ceramic, Drawing, Mixed Media, Painting, Computer Graphics, Sculpture, Photography, Printmaking, and Video/DVD Production

Works Eligible

All entries must be the original work of the student and not copies of another artist's work. Do not submit any work copied from published photographs, magazines, book illustrations or other artwork. All work must be signed by the student, parent or teacher attesting to its originality. If there is doubt as to the originality, the teacher should NOT submit it.

Artworks submitted to previous Middle Tennessee Regional Student Art Exhibitions are not eligible. Artworks completed in November 2012 through November 2013 are eligible to enter the competition.

Artists Eligible

The competition is open to students, grades 6-12, attending public, private, or home schools in the counties of West Tennessee. The number of entries entered into the competition may not exceed 2 artworks per student, and no more than 15 students per teacher.

Prizes will also be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each grade level.

The Best-of-Show Purchase Award

All high school entries are eligible for the Best-of-Show Purchase Award for which the artist receives the \$500 cash award, and the artwork will become part of the West Tennessee Regional Center's Permanent Collection.

The Best of the Best Exhibition

All artwork winning the Best-of-Show Purchase Award or any of the Best-of Categories will remain at The West Tennessee Regional Art Center until the Tennessee's Best of the Best Student Art Exhibition in Nashville. This artwork cannot be entered into any other competition until after the closing of the Best of the Best Exhibition. While this date is still to be determined, the Best of the Best Exhibition usually runs from late June through late August.

Judging

Selections for entry must be made in the schools. Entries violating any of the rules will be automatically disqualified before judging. Final selections for the exhibition and awards will be made by jury, and entrants will be notified of their acceptance or non-acceptance of their entries. Judging will be by categories and then by grade levels: 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, & 12th.

Presentation Form

- Photographs/works on paper must be framed or matted (preferably framed).
- Mats should be white (or off-white), gray or black.
- Paintings/Works on canvas do not require a frame, but do require a hanging wire.
- All 2-D works must arrive WIRED and ready to hang. If your work relies on any of the following materials to hang, it will be excluded from the show: duct tape, thread, saw-tooth hangers, yarn, masking tape, scotch tape, and/or sticky putty. Gaff tape and clear packaging tape are acceptable if used adequately.
- All entries must be sturdy enough to withstand normal handling and display.

Reasonable care of entries will be taken by the Student Art Exhibition Committee, but the Student Art Committee and the staff of the West Tennessee Regional Art Center assume no responsibility for the loss or damage to entries.

Delivery of Artwork

All accepted work must be delivered or dropped off at the West Tennessee Regional Art Center, 1200 Main Street, Humboldt, TN 38343, between the hours of 10am-5pm on December 13, 2013.

Picking Up Artwork after the Exhibition

After the exhibition closes, artwork must be picked up by a teacher or their designated representative March 12, 2014, between 10am and 4:30pm. Any artwork remaining at the West Tennessee Regional Art Center beyond 30 days of the pick-up date will be discarded.

Please label each file with the category entered, title of work, last name of student, and grade, each separated by an underscore (e.g. *painting_untitled_lastname_11.jpg*). Videos must be submitted in DVD Format.

There must be a signed entry form for each submission.
