# 14th Annual West Tennessee Regional Student Art Exhibition

Exhibition dates: January 17, 2022 – February 24, 2022
Deadline for entries: Monday, November 8, 2021
Delivery of accepted works: Thursday, December 9. 2021
Awards Reception: Sunday, January 16, 2022
Pick up date: Thursday, March 10, 2022

#### **Works Eligible**

All entries must be the original work of the students. Do not submit any work copied from published photographs, magazines, book illustrations, or other artwork. All work must be signed by the student and teacher attesting to its originality. If there is doubt as to the originality, the teacher should NOT submit it.

- Two dimensional works may not exceed 4 feet in any direction.
- Sculptures may not exceed 4 feet in any direction; weight limit is 50 pounds. Larger pieces will be considered, but only if the teacher is willing to personally transport the sculpture to/from WTRAC and to/from Nashville for the "Best of the Best" exhibition.
- Videos must contain original content and not exceed 5 minutes in length. Music must be original or copyright free.

Artwork submitted to previous West Tennessee Regional Student Art Exhibitions is not eligible.

Works completed from November 2020 through November 2021 are eligible to enter in the competition.

#### **Artists Eligible**

The competition is open to students, grades 6-12, attending public, private, or home schools in the counties of West Tennessee. The number of works entered into the competition may not exceed **2 per student**, and no more than **25 works entered per teacher**.

#### The Best-of-Show Purchase Award

All high school entries are eligible for the Best-of-Show \$500 Purchase Award. The entry selected will become part of the West Tennessee Regional Center's permanent student art collection.

<sup>\*</sup>Covid-19 conditions will determine whether the awards ceremony will be public or virtual.

#### The Best of the Best Exhibition

All artwork winning the Best-of-Show Purchase Award or any of the Best-of Categories will remain at The West Tennessee Regional Art Center until the Tennessee's Best of the Best Student Art Exhibition in Nashville. This artwork cannot be entered into any other competition until after the closing of the Best of the Best Exhibition. While this date is still to be determined, the Best of the Best Exhibition usually runs from late June through late August.

#### Judging

Selections for entry must be made in the schools. Entries violating any of the rules will be automatically disqualified before judging. Final selections for the exhibition and awards will be made by jury, and entrants' teachers will be notified of the acceptance (or non-acceptance) of entries. Accepted works/awards will be selected for grade levels 6 through 12. Best of show and of media categories will then be chosen from accepted works.

#### **Presentation Form**

- Photographs/works on paper must be framed or matted.
- Mats should be white (or off-white), gray, or black.
- Paintings/Works on canvas do not require a frame.
- All 2-D works must arrive WIRED and ready to hang. Please do not use: sawtooth hangers, yarn, masking tape, scotch tape, or sticky putty. Gaffers tape and clear packaging tape are sometimes acceptable for lightweight pieces. Sturdy foamcore or cardboard backing is required for all works on paper.
- All entries must be sturdy enough to withstand normal handling and display.

Reasonable care of entries will be taken by the Student Art Exhibition Committee, but the Student Art Committee and the staff of the West Tennessee Regional Art Center assume no responsibility for the loss or damage to entries.

#### **Delivery of Artwork**

All accepted work must be delivered to the West Tennessee Regional Art Center, 1200 Main Street, Humboldt, TN 38343, between the hours of 10am and 4:30pm on Thursday, December 9, 2020.

### Picking Up Artwork after the Exhibition

After the exhibition closes, artwork must be picked up by a teacher or designated representative on March 10, 2022, between 10am and 4:30pm. Any artwork remaining at the West Tennessee Regional Art Center beyond 30 days of the pick-up date could be discarded.

- November 8, 2021: Entry deadline
- November 18, 2021: Announcement of Accepted Entries
- December 9, 2021: Accepted artwork must be delivered (awards will be announced at the reception)
- January 16, 2022: Awards Ceremony & Reception, 2-4 pm (all participating student artists will be recognized)
- January 18 February 24, 2022: Exhibition Dates
- March 10, 2022: Pick-up date for artwork

#### **Entering Work**

Please fill out one entry form for each student. Teachers shall mail or deliver a flash drive containing high-resolution JPGs or PNG files of the students' artwork. Entry forms are to be **saved as pdfs\*** -- **NOT as scans**. One flash drive may contain all of the teacher's entries. Please note that flash drives will not be returned. With prior notification to WTRAC, entries (images and forms) may be submitted via Dropbox. Please attach a printed form to selected artwork before delivery.

\*Saving the individual completed entry forms as pdfs allows data to be copied/pasted for spreadsheets, labels, etc.

Please label each file with the category entered, teacher's last name\*, title of work, last name of student, grade, and size -- each separated by an underscore (e.g. *painting\_Jones\_untitled\_lastname\_11\_18x24.jpg*).
\*Please note that including **teachers' surnames** makes entries easier to sort and find in searches.
