- **Acceptance notifications: Tuesday, November 28, 2023**
- **Delivery, accepted works: Thursday, December 7, 2023**
- **Awards Reception: Sunday, January 21, 2024**
- **Pick up date: Thursday, March 7, 2024**

Works Eligible

All entries must be original work of the students. Entries must not be copied from published photographs, magazines, book illustrations, or other artwork. If there is doubt as to originality, it should NOT be submitted.

- Two dimensional works may not exceed 4 feet in any direction.
- Sculptures may not exceed 4 feet in any direction; weight limit is 50 pounds. Larger pieces will be considered, but only if the teacher is willing to personally transport the sculpture to/from WTRAC and to/from Nashville for the "Best of the Best" exhibition.
- Videos must contain original content and not exceed 5 minutes in length. Music: original or copyright free.

Works completed from November 2022 through November 2023. are eligible to enter in the competition.

Artists Eligible

The competition is open to students in grades 6-12, in public, private, or home schools in West Tennessee.. The number of works entered into the competition **may not exceed 2 per student; and no more than 25 per teacher.**

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place and one or more honorable mentions will be selected for each grade level.

The Best-of-Show Purchase Award

All high school entries are eligible for the Best-of-Show \$500 Purchase Award. The entry selected will become part of the West Tennessee Regional Center's permanent student art collection.

The Best of the Best Exhibition

All artwork winning the Best-of-Show Purchase Award or any of the Best-of-Categories will remain at the WTRC until the Tennessee's Best of the Best Student Art Exhibition during Arts Academy at Belmont

This artwork cannot be entered into any other competition until after the closing of the Best of the Best Exhibition.

Judging: Selection of works accepted and the awards will be made by jurors.

Presentation Form

- Photographs/works on paper must be framed or matted.
- Mats should be white (or off-white), gray, or black.
- Paintings/Works on canvas do not require a frame.

All 2-D works must arrive **WIRED and ready to hang**. Please do not use: sawtooth hangers, yarn, masking tape, scotch tape, or sticky putty. Gaffers tape and clear packaging tape are sometimes acceptable for lightweight pieces. **Sturdy foamcore or cardboard backing is required for all works on paper.**

Important: All entries must be sturdy enough to withstand normal handling and display.

Delivery of Artwork

All accepted work is to be delivered to the West Tennessee Regional Art Center, 1200 Main Street, Humboldt, TN 38343, between the hours of 10am and 4:30pm on **Thursday, December 7, 2023**.

Picking Up Artwork after the Exhibition

After the exhibition closes, artwork must be picked up by a teacher or designated representative on **Thursday, March 7, 2024**, between 10am and 4:30pm.

Entering Work: Please submit a separate form for each entry (**this is a change from last year**).

To insure timely preparation of entries for jurors, it is essential to label each file with: *category entered, teacher's surname, title of work, surname of student, grade, and size* -- each separated by an underscore.

Example: Painting_Smith_Untitled Masterpiece_Jones_10_18x24

It might be helpful for teachers submitting multiple entries to have a list with their names, contact numbers, school information, etc. in a Word document from which to copy & paste into the entry forms.

RELEASE INFORMATION

Entering the exhibition automatically grants permission for the West Tennessee Regional Art Center and the Tennessee Art Education Association to display the artwork and to use it in promotional materials.

WTRAC and TAEA will handle artwork with care and concern, but will assume no liability for loss or damage that might occur.
